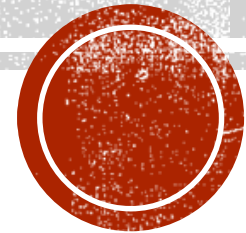

Medical Missionary Trainings

**Several Medical Missionaries
Trainings organized in our Division:**

ESUM: Trainings in Lomé, Niamey, and Ouagadougou: more than 140 MM trained

CMUM: Trainings in Yaoundé and in Bertoua with more than 170 MM trained

Trainings in ENUC.

One training in Monrovia (WAUM).



In WNUC and NNUC with the help of local and foreign volunteers: 12,011 primary cases seen, 130 surgeries, 3,125 eye care with 3,068 eye glasses distributed, 1,604 dental cases, 14 minor surgeries, 2,000 counselling by the Chaplain, with 3 baptisms.

CMUM with the contribution of ADRA Cameroon: more than 1,000 medical consultations, distribution of essential drugs worth 2 millions FCFA, 300 WASH (Water Sanitation and Hygiene) kits distributed

SGUC: the APC Team from the US and the Dental Team from LLU: 3,000 free medical consultations, with free medicines, free eye glasses, and health education, in Koforidua Adventist Hospital and the Middle North Ghana Conference.

Medical outreaches in Nouakchott (Mauritania) and in Nebo (Divo) with more than 350 free medical consultations.

Smoking cessation Programs: the Five Day Plan To Stop Smoking and Breathe Free

Training of 15 church members and Pastors in Mali.

Training of 400 Pastors and church members in Northern Cameroon (Maroua) and Mbam and Sanaga Conference

Development of Flipchart on the dangers of tobacco and the training of 10 young people from various associations and 10 imams on the use of the Flipcharts

Sensitization of the students in 4 schools in Nouakchott and the periphery on the dangers of smoking.

Five-Day Plan to stop Smoking organized in Institut Voltaire (Abidjan) with 2 smokers who decided to quit smoking

Five-Day Plan to Stop Smoking in Dakar (Senegal) with 60 smokers choosing to stop smoking, one of them already with lung cancer.
