





OUTREACH

A church planting projec was held at Ohroakpor in Ethiope East LGA in Delta State, Nigeria. 19 persons were baptized and a lamb shelter was built for worship. This project took place from November to December, 2016





 In 2018 another Church planting took place at Ediba Omin a suburb of Calabar city. God blessed this project with a total baptism of nine and some members joined to start the new church. After one year, the membership of this church has almost doubled as those who were not baptized initially finally gave their hearts to Christ. They are worshiping in the Lamb shelter.



• In February 2019, another church planting project took place at Nyahasang, another suburb of the Calabar city. Seven persons were baptized. The Land dispute which occured at the time of the project prevented the building of a lamb shelter, but praise God that the dispute has been resolved in favor of the church.





A two-week Revival program was conducted at Nyanya, Seventh-day Adventist Church at Abuja in February, 2017.




 Another two-week Revival Program was held at Oron in Akwa Ibom State in January, 2020 to prepare the church for an evangelistic outreach. Because of the Covid-19 the program did not hold.

A successful interview which requires a panel to interview a canditate with his spouse was held yesterday via zoom. This will open the doors for more endorsements despite the Covid-19 pandemic.

CLINICAL PASTORAL EDUCATION (CPE) The GC Adventist Chaplaincy Department had Approved and Inaugurated a Clinical Pastoral Education Training Center attached to the Babcock University Teaching Hospital. This center is the first set up by the church in the African Continent. This center will become fully functional by December this year.

More than 80 delegates had registered for the 3rd Adventist World Congress which will be held virtually beginning from today the 19th of October till Thursday the 22nd this week. 54 registered through the Division while the rest registered online.

- At the ellenwhite writings.org site we have free downloadable apps for these writings.






HERITAGE PROJECTS IN WAD

The Heritage Research team had worked in 9 out of the 10 Unions of this Division. The last one could not be visited because of the pandemic.

 In the course of this work, 13 Coutries were visited and 42 Heritage sites documented. Several original or scanned documents had been collected for research purposes, 34 recorded interviews and several artifacts collected.
